Thank you very much for choosing Long Lake. We are very excited with our plans so far and will make every effort to provide a stimulating, creative and fun summer.

BUSES - For the **2ND Three Week Session & 2ND Six Week Session's beginning on MONDAY July 19TH**, buses will be leaving at 8:00 AM FROM WEST ORANGE NJ, at 9:00 AM from South Jersey at the Joyce Kilmer Service Area between exits 8A and 9 on the NJ TURNPIKE NORTHBOUND, at 10:00 AM from QUEENS (Junction Blvd, side of Sears), 11:00 A.M. from WESTCHESTER (Cross County Shopping Center -YONKERS) and 2pm from Albany. All times are estimates due to the amount of traffic and any delays. Please pack a lunch for the trip and a juice box no cans or bottles please. If you are driving your child to camp please arrive after 2pm. More details in our May 1st letter.

BUSES - For the **3RD Three Week Session** beginning on **MONDAY August 9TH**, buses will be leaving at 8:00 AM FROM WEST ORANGE NJ, at 9:00 AM from South Jersey at the Joyce Kilmer Service Area between exits 8A and 9 on the NJ TURNPIKE NORTHBOUND, at 10:00 AM from QUEENS; 11:00 A.M. from WESTCHESTER (Cross County Shopping Center -YONKERS) and 2pm from Albany. All times are estimates due to the amount of traffic and any delays. If you are driving your child to camp please arrive after 2pm. More details in our May 1st letter.

THERE ARE NO CHARTERED BUSES RETURNING HOME- THE FINAL DAYS OF CAMP ARE VISITORS WEEKEND FILLED WITH ACCOMPLISHMENTS, WHICH YOU SHOULD ATTEND.

LUGGAGE You can bring one duffel bag or suitcase to the buses. Musical instruments, tennis racquet, sleeping bag, etc. can be carried onto the bus - NO TRUNKS CAN BE TAKEN.

TRUNKS Please note: trunks are not used at Long Lake, so pack a duffel.

MEDICAL The medical forms sent previously must be filled out accurately and completely. The N.Y.S. Health Department requires immunizations and the dates to be noted. This of course, is for your child's protection. If your child is undergoing any special medical or therapeutic treatment it is essential that we are notified. Please note all these details on the **medical form and Parents' Questionnaire** giving all details. The Doctors standing orders form must be filled out by a parent and your family doctor. This is a mandatory form and is for each camper's safety and protection. Both these forms can be found on our website.

CLOTHING A suggested one week's clothing- equipment guide is enclosed. Long Lake is not a dress up camp; functional clothing is practical and desirable. You can mark clothing with initials using an indelible laundry marker if desired. Much easier than name tags. Please see sweatshirt offer in this mailing.

LINEN SERVICE For your convenience we do have a linen service which will supply all the necessary linen items mentioned on the clothing list. The service fee will be \$50 for the entire 3 or 6 week stay. You can choose this option on the MAY 1 statement.

QUESTIONNAIRE Please take the time now to fill out both sides of the parents and camper questionnaire and return to us with the MAY 1st payment (or before). The information will greatly help us to fulfill both your wishes and goals for the summer program as well as your child's.

RENTAL CARS- Please do not rent a ZIP car as there is no cell phone reception at camp which you need to open you car doors!

HORSES Long Lake has an excellent English riding program. We own the horses and they are on camp property. Instruction includes walking, trotting, cantering, jumping, posting and trail-rides. See fees and instructions on the MAY 1st statement. If desired an order form for inexpensive riding boots is enclosed – please note that **WE SUPPLY HELMETS.**

CELL PHONES AND CALLING CARDS. Cell phones are not allowed at camp. Please send your camper with a calling cards. If your camper is flying to camp a cell phone is a good idea for the trip but they must hand them into the office please.

VISITING WEEKEND - **For the 2ND THREE WEEKS SESSION BEGINNING ON JULY 19th**- the Visitors Weekend begins on **SATURDAY AUGUST 7TH** at approx 9.30am and ends Sunday AUGUST 8TH at 3 PM. Times may change, please note updated information in our July mailing. Please see HOTEL/MOTEL GUIDE on separate sheet and book now. **Please plan on visiting for the entire time arriving the night before the first day.**

FOR THE 3RD THREE WEEK SESSION BEGINNING ON MONDAY AUGUST 9TH & SIX WEEKS SESSION BEGINNING MONDAY JULY 19TH - Visiting begins Friday AFTERNOON August 27TH at approx 2:00 PM and ends on Sunday Morning August 29TH at 9:00 AM .
